Useful information regarding the regular semester programme	<p>PURPAN recommends students to arrive from January, because the course offer is more important (no 4th and 5th year courses from October to December).</p> <p>Courses: students may choose uppermost among 3rd & 4th year courses. Access to 5th year courses is restricted; enrolment is subject to prior acceptance by PURPAN.</p>						
Grading system for regular semester programme	<p>Ecole d'Ingénieurs de PURPAN applies the ECTS grading scale, but applies a module average system for PURPAN students. Local examinations are graded from 1 to 20, and are translated into ECTS grades as described hereunder. To validate a course, exchange students must obtain at least 09,50/20.</p> <p>Some courses may not be graded but validated with ECTS based on attendance (with the mention "Pass").</p> <p>Some courses may be compensated according to PURPAN's compensation rules.</p>

Linguistic knowledge, prerequisite, preliminary French lessons, level tests	<p>For regular semesters:</p> <p>At PURPAN, the language of tuition is mostly French. Students need to have a level B1 in French at least (according to the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages). However, a level B2 is recommended.</p> <p>We will offer 30hours of French as a Foreign Language when students arrive at PURPAN; but the aim is not to reach a CEFRL level (like the B2 recommended), it's more to help students adapt to the change of language of tuition (oral + written) and eventually detect improvements to be made.</p> <p>Students may also sign up for French courses within the "Université Fédérale de Toulouse" (40€/module). Please contact Delphine SEGUI for more information.</p> <p>For EURAMA:</p> <p>In order to study in good conditions, we require a minimum level of English: TOEFL iBT: 80 (with speaking 20 min.) / IELTS: 6 (with speaking 6.0).</p> <p>For IBC:</p> <p>In order to study in good conditions, we require a minimum level of English: TOEFL iBT: 80 / TOEIC: 750 / IELTS: 6 / or equivalent.</p>						
Accommodation	<p>We can help students find accommodation upon request and according to offers received. Medical overage / Insurance	<p><u>Compulsory by French law:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Medical & Hospitalisation <p><u>For European students:</u> Copy of the European Health Insurance Card or an international insurance for the whole period of studies.</p> <p><u>For Non-European students:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - For non-EU students staying < to 3 months: International Private Insurance for the whole period of studies; - For non-EU students staying > 3 months: you must sign on (& pay) for the French student Social Security (215€ for 2015-2016 academic year). <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Personal Civil Liability (also called "third-party damage").
